“Lisa Bayakly, a school parent, is participating in the CEO Sleepout on 23 June 2016, which involves senior WA business leaders sleeping outside at the WACA on cardboard to raise awareness and funds to reduce homelessness. Lisa is concerned over 105,000 Australians are homeless, with almost half being women and over 10,000 children under 12. Over the last 2 years Lisa has raised \$17,000 in total, with her kids getting involved organising guess-a-jars and chocolate sales. This year she has raised \$1,600 to date with a month to go.
